



## What to Bring and What to Leave

Thanks for choosing Way back Inn. At the time of your admission, any item deemed inappropriate or excessive will need to be sent home with family/friends immediately or could potentially be disposed.

You will not be able to store anything with us outside of one small medication locker, one dresser, and/or shared closet space.

Please keep in mind, Way Back Inn does everything within reason to maintain a safe and secure living environment. However, Way Back Inn is not responsible for any lost or stolen items, and we recommend that you do not bring any high-value items.

### **What to bring:**

- Appropriate clothing for the season and employment, about 10-14 days' worth. Free laundry is available on-site, and WBI provides detergent.
- Closed-toe shoes with a hard sole and some sort of backing. For safety, slippers/slides/flip-flops and the like are not permitted to be worn anywhere within the houses except in the bedroom.
- Bath towels and alcohol-free bathing/grooming supplies (soap, shampoo, conditioner, etc.)
- You may bring a cell phone, but cell phones must be stored when not in-use. Cell phones are not to be used in-house or on-property, with the exception of specified cell phone time on the weekends. When out of the house to job-search or work, you may bring your phone. You will NOT have access to Way Back Inn wi-fi.
- Reading material, artwork, and personal photos and pictures are encouraged, but due to space should be kept to a minimum. Each client is provided with a small corkboard for personal photos and materials. Reading material may be kept on top of your personal dresser as space allows. Nothing can be hung on the walls.

### **What NOT to bring:**

- No bedding, pillows, or food. WBI supplies these items.
- No tablets, laptops, MP3 players, gaming systems, TVs, or any other kind of electronics will be allowed without pre-approval from staff.
- No wipes of any kind, including but not limited to makeup and baby wipes.
- No perfumes, sprays, and colognes.
- Nothing that requires an open flame, such as candles or incense.
- No weapons of any shape or size, including but not limited to pocket-knives, multi-tools containing knife blades (regardless of size or utility), mace/pepper spray, clubs, sticks, studded clothing & accessories/chain belts, etc.
- No items (clothing or otherwise) that advertises, describes, depicts any substance use, gambling, and/or sexual behaviors.
- No gambling-related material such as dice, dominoes, and cards.
- No furniture.
